Job Title: **IT Service Management Systems and Asset Lead**

Purpose of the Job

To ensure efficient IT Service Delivery by administering and optimising the IT Service Management (ITSM) platform. Maintaining accurate IT asset and licence registers, producing actionable reports on service performance and asset statuses. The role combines system administration, asset lifecycle management and data-driven reporting to support compliance, operational excellence and continuous improvement.

Principal Responsibilities

- Administer, configure and develop the ITSM platform, optimising workflows, automations, forms, roles and dashboards to align with ITIL processes and improve SLA performance.
- Own the IT asset and software license cycle (procure, record, deploy, track, recover and dispose), maintaining accurate registers and CMDB relationships, whilst completing scheduled audits and reconciliations.
- Design and deliver reporting analytics for service performance and asset status; analyse trends to identify problems, risks and continual improvement opportunities; produce regular and ad-hoc dashboards for stakeholders.
- Collaborate with the Service Desk, Infrastructure, Procurement, Applications and Projects teams to enable effective change, releases and transformations, ensuring asset and service data quality and readiness.
- Liaise with suppliers and partners for system enhancements, licensing compliance, asset tracking services and warranty/maintenance support; manage issues to resolution and escalate as required.
- Define, document and improve policies, procedures and controls for ITSM and IT asset management to meet security, audit and local government compliance requirements.
- Provide subject-matter advice, guidance and training to colleagues and end-users on ITSM use, asset procedures and reporting, champion good data quality and process adherence.
- Contribute to business continuity, audit activities and remediation plans related to ITSM and asset/CMDB data; support incident/problem/change governance.

General Responsibilities

- Demonstrate awareness/understanding of equal opportunities and other people's behavioural, physical, social and welfare needs.
