Overall purpose of the post

1. To support adults in group learning environments (face to face and online). Directed and supported by the Learner Support Advisor you will play a key role in enabling learners with additional needs to participate and engage in learning.

Principal responsibilities

- 1. Works under supervision/guidance enabling access to learning, including any additional needs
- 2. Interact with colleagues, learners, carers, other educational professionals. Attend staff meetings and training as appropriate
- Assist learners within the class, individually or in small groups (sometimes
 outside the classroom) in the completion and adjustment of a wide range of predefined learning, care and support activities to meet the individual needs
- 4. Provide specific support in the virtual delivery of the mental health/LLDD programme
- Supervise and support learners in the learning environment, including more indepth support for those with additional needs, to promote independence, selfreliance, inclusion and acceptance
- Support, as appropriate, on trips and visits as part of extended learning opportunities
