Purpose of Post	To assist with the day-to-day management of the Country Parks

PRINCIPAL RESPONSIBILITIES

- Assist with the day-to-day management of Country Parks including opening and closing, security, maintenance and visitor services. Primarily over weekends and school holidays.
- 2. To undertake park management, estate maintenance tasks including the minor maintenance of machinery, tools and equipment.
- 3. Maintain cleanliness and appearing of park and its facilities to a high standard. (Inc. toilets)
- 4. To lead and supervise voluntary staff, work placements and public groups including special needs groups and individuals as directed.
- 5. Undertake fishery bailiffing duties as directed.
- 6. To assist with park events and other group activities, if required, including giving guided walks and talks.
- 7. To deal with emergencies and summon assistance where necessary.
- 8. To patrol the park, assist the visitors and encourage compliance with the park byelaws and the country code.
- 9. To ensure that reasonable care is always taken for health, safety and welfare and to comply with the policies and procedures relating to health and safety within the Service, including undertaking risk assessments for activities and ensuring safe delivery of activities on the day.
- 10. To carry out any other duties which fall within the broad spirit, scope and purpose of this job description.

Note - A uniform is provided and must be worn. You are not allowed to have dogs with you whilst on duty. This post is subject to DBS checks.

This job description reflects the major tasks to be carried out by the post holder and identifies a level of responsibility at which they will be required to work. In the interests of effective working, the major tasks may be reviewed from time to time to reflect changing needs and circumstances. Such reviews and any consequential changes will be carried out in consultation with the post holder.
